A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELDING, MICHIGAN
AUTHORIZING THE REQUEST TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE HIGH STREET BETWEEN
I.O. STREET AND RANNEY STREET FOR A COMMUNITY EVENT.

WHEREAS, a request was received from the Holy Cross Lutheran Church to temporarily close High Street, between I.O. Street and Ranney Street, for a community event on Saturday, June 27, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the closure will provide a safe area for the community members to enjoy the music, activities and refreshments offered at the event.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Belding, Michigan that High Street, between I.O. Street and Ranney Street, be closed on June 27, 2009 from 3 p.m. to 9 p.m. for a community event hosted by Holy Cross Lutheran Church.
