Please keep selling to a minimum!

- All exhibitors will provide their own display items and backdrops.
- Electricity is limited! Electricity may be provided if it is marked on the application and will be available on a first-come, first serve basis.
- You **MUST** provide your own heavy-duty electrical extension cords and/or power bar.

Registration: Space is assigned on a first-come, first-serve basis. You must complete and return the form!

Parking: To allow as much convenience to our visitors as possible, exhibitors **MUST** park in designated areas behind the building. You will enter the rear parking lot of the building. The driveway is east of the bowling alley and is adjacent to the BAS bus garage.

Door Prizes: Door prizes are optional—if you would like to offer door prizes you may do so at your booth. Contacting winners and delivering prizes is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor offering the prize and will **NOT** be announced. There will be a board by the main office where you may post winners’ names.

Exhibits: All exhibits shall be kept neat in appearance and in good taste. The Showcase Committee reserves the right to regulate all exhibits and displays which may be considered objectionable/inconsistent with the goals of this event. Exhibitors are requested to clean their display area when vacating. Wall space is very limited because of lockers. If you would like to have something behind your booth, you’ll need to construct it in advance.

Set up: **Setup will be from 3:30 to 4:45 on the day of the event.** We will have BHS students and carts to help you unload your car from the rear of the building.
